Music: Armchair Adventures theme

Scene 1

Connie: Good morning, good evening, good afternoon wherever you're listening from adventurers! The voices of today's join in at home adventurers are:

Connie: As it's Halloween me and my friends at school have decided to make our very own scary Halloween moooooovie! It's going to be awesome. Only problem is that I've never made a movie before, so I've set my Uncle Chris and our local community theatre group a mission to collect the top ten ingredients I need to make a super scary moooooovie! I can't wait to hear back from them. It's going to be another amazing and slightly spooky episode of Armchair Adventures.

SFX Halloween sounds

Unc. Chris: Thanks Connie. Hi adventurers. Let's get our local community theatre company on a group telephone chat, because with an Armchair Adventure adventurers, we can go anywhere we like from the comfort of where we are right now, so they're perfect for everyone, no matter what age you are. Start. Call. Now.



SFX Phone rings

The theatre group say various hellos...

Danny: Today is an exciting day Uncle Chris.

Unc. Chris: Oh yeah, why's that?

Danny: It's Halloween and it's a full moon.

SFX night, owls.

Unc. Chris: Oh I see. That is exciting.

John: And we have a new person at our community theatre group today.

Unc. Chris: Oh yes...

Katie: Her name is Harriet Howling. Say hello to Uncle Chris and the adventurers Harriet.

SFX scratching sounds.

Harriet: Hello adventurers my name's Harriet Howling. Sorry about all the scratching. I'm always like this on Halloween. Or perhaps I'm just nervous.

SFX scratching stops.

Dan: Don't worry Harriet. Whenever someone new comes to our community theatre group we always make them super welcome and comfortable.

The theatre group welcome Harriet

Julia: We make them a nice cup of tea.

Katie: And a biscuit.

SFX sounds of making tea and biscuit.

Ann: We smile at them to let them know we are pleased to see them.

Habib: We show them the ropes, to make sure they know where everything is and how things work.



Gill: We make them feel included and listened to.

Gary: We play a name game so everyone gets know each other...

SFX of a theatre group workshop.

We hear the customers playing a name game

Unc. Chris: I know adventurer, I love a bit of drama, so let's play a drama name game right now. I want you all to tell me your name and then use the first letter of your name to think of an action. So for example, Uncle Chris meows like a cat... 'Meeeeooooow'

SFX of Uncle Chris pretending to be a cat.

Unc. Chris: Get it. Chris. Cat. They start with the same letter, or Uncle Chris cries like a baby.

Uncle Chris cries

Anne: Anne is angry, grrrrrr!!

Dan: Dan is dancing...5, 6, 7, 8!

SFX club/dance music

Gary: Gary is giggling!

Gary laughs

Unc. Chris: Join in adventurers.

SFX ding

Adventurer: Magic Max!

SFX magic 'ta-dah'

Adventurer: Cobi cooks!

SFX cooking

Adventurer: Isabel investigates....hmmm what's this?



SFX of unravelling paper just before Isabel says 'what's this?'

Adventurer: Maya the monkey!

SFX monkeys

Unc. Chris: They were amazing adventurers. Harriet, would you like a turn?

Harriet: Harriet howls.

SFX of (very impressive) werewolf howl

Ann: Wow that was an impressive impression of a werewolf Harriet.

Mike: Yes, very realistic.

Harriet: Errm yes an impression. Obviously. Thank you.

Unc. Chris: Well it was lovely getting to know you all and hearing your names and actions, but we better get on with our mission from Connie.

Gary: Hold on where's Chris?

Katie: I thought it was quiet.

Unc. Chris: I'm here.

Gary: Not you Uncle Chris. We have a regular member of our community theatre group also named Chris.

Paul: It's not like him to miss a session.

Dan: Maybe he's at his karate lessons.

SFX Chris entering in dramatic style, doors banging, footsteps etc.

Chris: Sorry I'm late everybody. Hi Uncle Chris. Oh, hi Adventurers.

Unc. Chris: Hi Chris. Why are you late?

Chris: I've been bitten.

SFX thunder and lighting



Chris: I was eating a sandwich full of jam for my breakfast and suddenly I looked down and there was bloody teeth marks on my leg.

Paul: Was it plum?

Chris: No it was my leg?

Paul: No, the jam.

Chris: Oh it was red strawberry, very sticky and very tasty too.

Ann: Maybe it's a mosquito bite?

Mike: Or a squirrel?

Chris: The bite marks are too big for that.

SFX static as if an old fashion radio broadcast has been interrupted.

Music: News theme (accompanying below text)

Reporter 1: We interrupt this podcast to bring you breaking news. A huge hairy hound has inexplicably escaped from the local dog pound. Staff have reported it was as if the animal just got up and walked out the door, just like a human would.

Reporter 2: Well it is Halloween Clyde, and a full moon tonight, perhaps we have a werewolf on our hands.

Reporter 1: Hahaha, you do make me laugh Bonnie. But seriously folks the dog is very dangerous and must not be approached in any circumstances.

SFX static as if an old fashion radio broadcast has been interrupted.

Music fades out with static.

Paul: Werewolf on the loose.

Katie: Oh no, we are going to be eaten alive!

Gill: Don't worry Harriet we'll protect you from the escaped werewolf.

SFX scratching

Harriet: Protect me. Yes of course. Thanks.

SFX scratching stops

Unc. Chris: There's no such thing as werewolves you lot. No time for worrying about all that. Connie has asked us to collect our top ten ingredients for making a scary movie. And as you know I love a bit of drama, so I've been thinking.

Dan: I thought we could smell something burning.

Unc. Chris: Cheeky. Let's go to the studio and record another chart show like we did for the panto episode last Christmas!

The theatre groups all give positive reactions

Unc. Chris: Come on then, let's get on with it, we have a TV programme to make. A journey of the imagination here we come because it's time to record an episode of.... Top of the Scary Movie Pops!

Music: Armchair Adventures theme (instrumental only) with...

SFX scary sounds: howling, creaking doors etc.

Scene two

Music: Top of The Scary Movie Pops showbiz music

Uncle Chris: Welcome movie makers to another fantastic tip-top 'join in at home' episode of 'Top of the Scary Movie Pops!' In today's show, we take a jam-packed trip through our local community theatre groups top ten ingredients that make up a proper good scary movie! So, let's go straight in at number ten....

John: Hi movie makers it's me John here.

Adventurers: Hi John!

Music fades out as below SFX fade in

John: At number 10 it's setting the scene.

SFX scary sounds to accompany the following dialogue...

Mike: Graveyards...

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Habib: An abandoned mine...

Danny: A haunted fun fair...

Julia: Spooky Woods...

SFX stop

John: Where would you set your scary movie adventurers?

SFX ding

Adventurer: Under the water in a haunted ship.

Adventurer: A haunted castle.

Adventurer: A spooky house.

Adventurer: A haunted tomb.

Adventurer: An abandoned hospital.

Adventurer: A haunted spaceship.

Katie: I'd set mine in a florist.

Paul: A florist?

Katie: Yes, a place that sells flowers.

Paul: But they're not scary?

Katie: They are for me, I'm allergic! I have allergies.

SFX sneeze

Paul: Bless you.

Katie: Thank you.

Music: Top of The Scary Movie Pops showbiz music fades in



Unc. Chris: Well Connie is a budding filmmaker so maybe she will choose a florist. Get it. Budding. Flowers.....

SFX tumbleweed

Unc. Chris: ...Maybe not. At nine, down from last year, we have my namesake Chris with spooky weather.

SFX of a stormy night

Adventurers: Hi Chris.

Music: Top of The Scary Movie Pops showbiz music fades out

Chris: The weather in scary movies is important to the story adventurers and helps to create a scary atmosphere.

SFX lashing winds and rain, crack of thunder under the below dialogue

Gary: Scary movies often start on a stormy night, with fog, rain, thunder, lightning, and strong winds lashing against the side of an old house high up on a hill for example.

Dan: Yes and then the wind blows the windows of the house wide open.

SFX windows blowing open.

John: And the curtains begin flapping in the wind.

SFX flapping curtains

Dan: And suddenly, the wind blows the candles out! And throws everyone into complete darkness.

SFX electric buzz and bang

The theatre group react to the light going out

Danny: And you adventurer, pretend you're in the dark in a haunted house.

SFX Ding

Adventurer: Arrghhh...what was that?

Adventurer: Ohhh, it's well scary!



Adventurer: Watch out for the ghosts!

Adventurer: Let's get to safety together.

Katie: Oh look everybody, now the lights are out you can see how clear the sky is. We'll be able to see the full moon no problem when the sun goes down. Not long now.

SFX scratching sounds

Katie: Are you ok Harriet?

Harriet: Yes, just itchy.

SFX scratching sounds

Chris: You've got me at it now Harriet. It must be catching! I don't know, first I get bitten on the leg and now I can't stop itching, some Halloween this is?!

Unc. Chris: Someone put the big light on for goodness sake and let's get on with the show...

SFX buzz of electricity and light switch

Music: Top of The Scary Movie Pops showbiz music fades in

Unc. Chris: That's better. Now in the top ten scary movie pops for as long as I can remember it's number 8 with Gary and strange noises.

Adventurers: Hi Gary

Music: Top of The Scary Movie Pops showbiz music fades out

Gary: There's lots of scary noises in scary movies you know.

Ann: Blood curdling screams...

SFX Blood curdling screams

Julia: Rats scurrying about...

SFX Rats scurrying about

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Habib: Scary voices..

Unc. Chris: What's the scariest voice you can do adventurer?

SFX ding

Adventurer: I'm going to get you.

Adventurer: I see you

Adventurer: Roaaaaarrrrr!

Unc. Chris: They are brilliant. You are clever.

Gary: The strange noises in scary movies often come from the basement...and then some idiot goes to investigate. Why do the people in scary movies always do that? If I heard a scary noise I'd hide, or stay in bed, or better still leave the house and never come back.

SFX fart squeaky noise.

Katie: What was that?

Gary: I think it's a strange noise in the basement, I might go and investigate.

Katie: I don't think so Gary. You stay right where you are.

SFX sniffing

Katie: There's a right scary whiff in here now. It wasn't a noise from the basement it was your gassy bum again.

Gary: How dare you?

SFX fart squeaky noise.

Gary: Sorry.

Music: Top of The Scary Movie Pops showbiz music fades in

Unc. Chris: Will someone open a window? And now it's number seven, Katie and Gill with a recipe for fake blood.

Adventurers: Hi Katie. Hi Gill.



Music: Top of The Scary Movie Pops showbiz music fades out

Gill: You need lots of blood in a scary movie.

Katie: This is our favourite recipe.

SFX of making the recipe: kitchen sounds, spoon stirring etc.

Gill: And the best thing is it's edible and delicious.

Katie: Two tablespoons of syrup to create a thick, sticky base for the mixture.

Gill: One tablespoon of red food colouring for obvious reasons.

Katie: Half a teaspoon of Cocoa powder to darken the colour.

Gill: That's all you need! Just mix them together and you should have something resembling sticky, dark red blood.

SFX mixing the ingredients together

Chris: It looks a bit like the jam I had on my breakfast sandwich.

Katie: Let us know how you get on adventurers?

SFX ding

Adventurer: The red food colouring really helped mine.

Adventurer: It was so realistic!

Adventurer: I scared my dad pretending to have a nose bleed!

Adventurer: It went all over the place!

Music: Top of The Scary Movie Pops showbiz music fades in



Unc. Chris: Welcome back movie makers. At number six, down three places from last year, it's Julia with shadows.

Adventurers: Hi Julia.

Music: Top of The Scary Movie Pops showbiz music fades out

Julia: I think shadows are really scary.

John: Absolutely Julia. All spooky things happen in the shadows.

Chris: I like shadows me! I try and box mine. Come on adventurer try and box your shadow with me.

SFX ding

SFX boxing sounds

The adventurers and theatre group pretend to box

Mike: I try and run away from mine. Come on adventurer see if you can outrun your shadow.

SFX ding

SFX starters gun, running race, crowd cheering

The theatre group and adventurers are panting and puffing as if running

Music: Top of The Scary Movie Pops showbiz music fades in

Unc. Chris: (out of breath) well that was exhausting. Number five for the fourth year running it's Habib and Danny with potions, spells, and rituals.

Adventurers: Hi Habib. Hi Danny.

Music: Top of The Scary Movie Pops showbiz music fades out

Habib: I know let's make a magic potion.

Danny: Imagine you've got a bubbling cauldron in front of you everyone.

SFX bubbling cauldron.

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Danny: What will you put in it?

Gill: A bats wing and a rabbit's foot...

Katie: Mouldy mushrooms and a dollop of earwax...

Gary: A spotty green frog...

Dan: A hairy spider...

John: A hand full of wriggling caterpillars.

Habib: What about you adventurer?

Danny: What will you put in the cauldron for our magic potion?

SFX ding

Adventurer: A rotten brain!

Adventurer: A sticky old eyeball!

Adventurer: Pig's ear!

Adventurer: A smelly sock!

Adventurer: I'm gonna put a rotten toe in!

Adventurer: Bloooooooooood!

SFX bubbling cauldron stops

Music: Top of The Scary Movie Pops showbiz music fades in

Unc. Chris: Oh my, we are storming through these. We're on number four already, so here's John with characters.

Music: Top of The Scary Movie Pops showbiz music fades out

John: You have to have some good characters in a scary movie. My favourite is the monsters and ghouls. You know, like witches for example.

SFX witch's cackle

Gary: Or vampires



SFX vampire "I want someones blood!"

Chris: Zombies.

SFX zombie

Katie: Mummies.

SFX Mummies

John: What's your favourite character in a scary movie adventurer?

SFX Ding

Adventurer: Frankenstein...

Adventurer: Dracula...

Adventurer: A mummy...

Adventurer: Check out my ghost impression... 'whooooooo'

Adventurer: A creepy doll... 'I'm right behind youuuuuuu!'

Unc. Chris: What an impressive list of characters.

SFX scratching

Harriet: Erm erm errr...

Unc. Chris: Sorry Harriet did you have another character in mind.

Harriet: Well you forgot werewolf.

SFX very impressive werewolf

John: That was an incredible impression Harriet. It's almost as if there was a werewolf in the room.

Katie: Maybe the one that escaped from the pound.

Dan: That wasn't a werewolf that escaped from the pound Katie. It was just a
a
big dog.



Katie: Still.

Chris: Let me have a go at a werewolf impression.

SFX another very impressive werewolf.

Chris: I didn't even know I could do that.

Music: Top of The Scary Movie Pops showbiz music fades in

Unc. Chris: We are on number three and up from last year it's Dan with scary action sequences.

Adventurers: Hi Dan

Music: Top of The Scary Movie Pops showbiz music fades out

Dan: I guess the best bit of a scary movie for me is the action sequences. Like when the vampire bites the victim's neck. Or when the mummy comes back to life. Or when the zombie eats brains.

Gill: I don't fancy brains for my tea do you?!

Mike: It's more like a snack than your tea with my brain Gill.

Katie: Like an olive on a stick do you mean Mike?

Mike: I was thinking more like a scotch egg to be honest Katie.

Music: Top of The Scary Movie Pops showbiz music fades in

Unc. Chris: Well Mike what you claim to lack in brains you definitely make up in acting prowess, it's number two with Mike and dramatic deaths.

Adventurers: Hi Mike!

Music: Top of The Scary Movie Pops showbiz music fades out

Mike does a dramatic death. "im dying, uugggh"

Unc. Chris: That was amazing Mike. Very dramatic indeed.

Gary: Here, let me have a go. Caaw caaw



Gary tries and fails to do a dramatic death.

Katie: That sounds like a dying crow. It wasn't very dramatic Gary.

Gary: I'll work on it!

Unc. Chris: Can you do a dramatic death adventurer?

SFX ding

Adventurer: I'm dyyyyying...urgh!

Adventurer: What was in this drink....arghhhh!

Adventurer: Arghhhhh!

Adventurer: Arghhhhh help me!

Adventurer: Arrrrrrrghhhhhhhhhhhhhhhhh!

Music: Top of The Scary Movie Pops showbiz music fades in

Unc. Chris: Those were amazing adventurers. We're finally here and just in time, it's almost dark outside. And it's suddenly gone very cold. In fact I'll pop this electric heater on...

SFX blast of electric heater

Unc. Chris: That's better. At number one it's Ann and Harriet with music.

Adventurers: Hi Ann. Hi Harriet.

Music: Top of The Scary Movie Pops showbiz music fades out

Ann: Music is the main ingredient in a scary movie for me. It helps build the tension and the suspense like this....

Music: Tense and suspense filled music.

SFX scratching.

Ann: Are you ok Harriet?

Harriet: You'll have to finish this one without me Ann, I'm just gonna pop to the



toilet.

Julia: They're just through the big doors Harriet.

SFX scratching.

Harriet: Thanks Julia, that's very kind of you. I must rush.

Julia: That's fine Harriet, I always take special care of new people.

SFX Harriet leaving footsteps through big doors but we can still hear more scratching.

Gary: I can still hear scratching noises. Who's scratching now?

Chris: Sorry it's me. This blooming scratching I've caught from Harriet.

SFX scratching.

Ann: So back to the music. The closer we get to the scary bit, the more and more suspenseful the music gets.

Music gets more suspenseful

SFX Grrrrrr

SFX scratching like on a door.

Danny: Chris will you stop scratching.

Chris: It's not me this time.

Katie: It's coming from the big doors.

Dan: Somebody or something is scratching on the big doors.

Mike: Trying to get in.

SFX Grrrrrr

SFX big bang as the fuse blows and...

Music stops abruptly at a climax

The theatre group all scream

Katie: What on earth was that?

Unc. Chris: With all the lights and cameras and now that electric heater I just switched on, I bet that bang was a blown fuse. I'll go down to the basement to investigate.

Gary: The basement!?! Are you sure that's a good idea Uncle Chris?

Unc. Chris: I'll be fine. The basement stairs are only just backstage through this trap door here.

Chris: I'll come and help you Uncle Chris. Two Chris's together.

Unc. Chris: Are you sure Chris, you look don't look your normal self. In fact, you look dog rough.

Katie: One sick puppy all right.

Dan: Yes, to be fur you do look paw-ly Chris!

Gill: Maybe it's connected to that bite from earlier?

Chris: Will you lot stop 'hounding' me. Uncle Chris 'lead' on to the basement.

Unc. Chris: If you're sure.

SFX of Uncle Chris and Chris opening a creaky trap door going down some stairs to the basement.

Unc. Chris: *(As is heard from further away, down the basement).* It's pretty dark down here too. Hold on. I've found the fuse box and here's a toolkit to fix it. Don't worry I'll get the lights back on before you know it. Chris... Could you..? Chris?

SFX thud

SFX werewolf esq howl (Uncle Chris has hurt his thumb).

Habib: What's that noise now?

Dan: It came from the basement?

SFX fartly squeaky noise.



Katie: Gary! And now there's another scary whiff about the place again!

Gary: Sorry. I think I need the toilet now as well.

Gill: It's just through the big doors Gary, where the scratching and growling noises were coming from.

SFX scratching

SFX growling.

Dan: And now there back. Scratching? Growling? Could it be....?

Gary: Thanks Gill. I won't be a mo everyone.

SFX Gary footsteps going to leave.

SFX the music builds again.

Dan: Gary nooooooooo....!!! Don't open the big door!

SFX big doors opening

SFX squeaky fart

SFX Giant dog leaping in. Grrrs and barking

Danny: It's a werewolf! Help!

Gill: Hide everybody!

SFX of the theatre group scurrying to hide

SFX big dog breathing

Katie: Now everyone quiet. Maybe it's not hungry.

SFX Big dog Grrrr

Gill: I think that might be wishful thinking.

Unc. Chris: *(from the basement)* Chris would you... No Chris, please....for the love of...

SFX thud

SFX howl from basement (Uncle Chris has hurt his thumb again)

SFX we here the dog prowling around the room, panting etc.

Habib: I think there's another werewolf in the basement. Uncle Chris and Chris may be in trouble.

Katie: And where's Gary?

SFX (from off) Gary does a dramatic death from off

Katie: And now something's got Gary!

Dan: He must have been bitten on his way to the toilet.

Gill: First a big hairy dog escapes from the pound in suspicious circumstances...

Dan: Then we suddenly get a new person join the group...

Habib: That can't stop scratching...

Katie: On Halloween with a full moon in the sky.

Danny: And Chris got bitten remember. Are you thinking what I'm thinking?

The theatre group react in agreement

Katie: What are we going to do?

SFX thud.

SFX Howling from the basement (Uncle Chris has hurt his thumb again)!

SFX Uncle Chris fixing the fusebox

Unc. Chris: That should have done it.

SFX switch flicking and then electric buzz as the lights power back up

The theatre group cheer as the lights being back on

SFX Uncle Chris and Chris walk up from the basement and shut the trap door

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Unc. Chris: Sorry for all the howling. Chris kept catching my thumb with the hammer from the toolkit.

Chris *(from the basement)*. Sorry Uncle Chris.

Unc. Chris: That's ok Chris. The fuse just needed changing.

Ann: Now we have the lights back on, we can all see that big dog.

SFX big dog panting with a little grrr running over to Ann

Ann. You're not scary are you boy? Don't worry everyone I'm great with dogs. Here boy. You're ok. I'll look after you.

Katie: I don't think it's a boy Ann. I think it's a girl and I think her name is Harriet Howling.

SFX thunder and lightning

SFX Big doors creak open

Harriet: Ooo it's a dog. I love dogs too Ann. Sorry Katie to interrupt you. That must be the one who escaped from the pound. Let's tickle him behind the ears. My dog at home loves that.

SFX tickling a dog behind the ears. (Who's a good boy)

Katie: Harriet?! You're...?!

Harriet: What Katie?

Katie: Well you're here and so is the dog.

Harriet: Yes I am. Sorry about all that scratching, too many sweet things can bring me out in a rash, I think I might be allergic like you and the flowers, and you know what it's like at Halloween- sweeties galore.

Chris: Me too Harriet. I think I overdid it on that jam this morning.

SFX dog running up to Chris, dog panting etc.

Chris: Hello boy.

Habib: He likes you.

MADE BY MORTALS

Dan: What's he doing to your leg?

SFX licking sounds

Chris: He's licking that bite from this morning. Hold on a minute, he's licked it off.

Dan: You can't lick off a bite.

Chris: Let me have a lick boy. Budge over..

Danny: I didn't know you were that flexible Chris?!

Habib: Licking your own leg that's impressive.

Chris: That'll be my karate lessons.

SFX Chris licking his leg!

Chris: It's jam! Red sticky strawberry jam! What a plum! I thought I'd been bitten but I must have just spilt my jam.

Katie: But what about Gary? We heard him get killed off, and now he's not here?

SFX Big doors opening

Gary: Hi everyone. Oh, you've seen it's just a big dog, not a werewolf. I've been practising my dramatic deaths in the toilet. I'm getting really good at them. Check this out...

Gary does a dramatic death.

Everyone laughs

Katie: Gary!

Dan: He's a one!

Julia: Oh Gary, what you like!

Music: Top of The Scary Movie Pops showbiz music fades in

Unc. Chris: So that's the end of Top of the Scary Movie Pops. See you next time movie makers.



Music ends

Unc. Chris: And cut! Great show everyone.

SFX of TV crew packing away.

Unc. Chris: Did you enjoy your first session at the community theatre company Harriet?

Harriet: Loved it. Thank you everyone and you adventurer.

Unc. Chris: Lovely. Remember to make new people feel welcome whenever you can adventurers. And remember to be brave and try new things, just like Harriet did. And now it's time to say goodbye to the imaginary world and get back to reality.

Everyone says goodbye

Unc. Chris: End. Call. Now.

SFX phone down.

Unc. Chris: Great! I have the all the info I need to give to Connie now. I hope she and her school friends have as much fun making their scary movie as we've had filming Top of the Scary Movie Pops! Bye for now and happy Halloween.

SFX static as if an old fashion radio broadcast has been interrupted.

Music: News theme (accompanying below text)

Reporter 1: We interrupt this podcast. For one last time to bring you breaking news. The huge hairy hound has been returned. A source said they were over the full moon to have the dog back. So much so, the community theatre company that returned him has been given a healthy reward.

Reporter 2: A healthy reward eh Clyde?! I bet they've been paid by the pound! Paid by the pound... get it. Pound?!
