SFX Ding

Adventurers singing:

Mrs Maestro! Mrs Maestro! Mrs M: You've got it! Mrs Maestro, Mrs Maestro!

Mrs M (sung): My name is Mrs Maestro and I own a bus company.

I've travelled the country and I've faced many bumps in the road.

So whenever you need to get from A to B,

Just call Mrs Maestro, that's me! What's my name Adventurers?

Adventurers singing:

Mrs Maestro! Mrs Maestro! Mrs Maestro! Mrs Maestro!

Mrs M (sung): My name is Mrs Maestro and I own a bus company.

I'm always on time, I'm always very friendly. So whenever you need to get from A to B,

Just call Mrs Maestro, that's me! What's my name adventurers?

SFX Ding

Adventurers singing:

Mrs Maestro! Mrs Maestro!

Mrs M: You got it!

Mrs Maestro! Mrs Maestro!

Connie: In the last episode, we met the wonderful Mrs Maestro and we're

helping her collect the musicians from an orchestra, so they can get to the super doper concert on time! We picked up the woodwind family from the park and now everyone is back on the bus, but we are

running late for our pick-ups already and Mrs Maestro can't remember

the route.

Mrs M: Don't worry Connie. You and the adventures, and your customers are

going to help me by singing my route song. Don't forget to count the

beat with your hands. Ready. Well off we go!

Music: Route Song

Mrs M & Everyone: Music, music, 1, 2, 3, 4.

Music, music, I've got to pick up an orchestra.

Music, music, 1, 2, 3, 4. And this is my order...

First I collect the woodwind from the park.

(Woodwind play)

Next it is the strings from the ice cream parlour.

(Strings play)

(Brass play)

(Percussion play).

SFX Bus Pulling up.

Mrs M: We're here. The string family at the ice cream parlour. Can you

imagine it?

Music: The Ice Cream Parlour

Mrs M: A giant scoop of ice cream, swirls of raspberry sauce, loads of rainbow

sprinkles and a cherry on the top.

SFX making an ice cream

Linda: She's doing it again.

Pat: Making hand movements to the music.

Mrs M: A giant scoop of ice cream, swirls of raspberry sauce, loads of rainbow

sprinkles and a cherry on the top.

SFX making an ice cream

Pat: First she pretends to scoop a ball of ice cream from a giant tub and

plops it in a bowl from up high.

SFX A giant scoop of ice cream out of a tub

Christine: Then she swirls her hand and arms down like lashings of raspberry

sauce.

SFX swirls of raspberry sauce hitting a sundae

Walter: And then she uses her fingers to make it rain rainbow sprinkles.

SFX loads of rainbow sprinkles falling onto a sundae.

Keith: Then she plucks a juicy cherry and pops it on the top.

SFX A cherry on the top.

Connie: Why don't you make gestures with your hands to represent the things

you can see in the ice cream parlour adventurers? Remember be

guided by the music.

SFX Ding

Mrs M: A giant scoop of ice cream, swirls of raspberry sauce, loads of rainbow

sprinkles and a cherry on the top.

Music Stops

SFX making and eating ice creams

Lilly: These ice-creams are delicious

Anne: Mines a large cornet

Keith: Mmm mmm!

Pat: Strawberry for me— you can't beat the classic flavours.

Walter: A vat of vanilla

Cyril: Pistachio.

Ronnie: Caramel.

Anne: Mines got a sparkler and an umbrella in the top.

Ronnie: I'm eating mine with a giant spoon.

Christine: Well, I'm a tutti fruitti!!

Connie: What's your favourite ice cream combination adventurers?

Advneturers Responses

SFX Bus. Grumbles. Horn.

Adventure 1: Strawberry ice cream with sauce and sprinkles

Adv 2: Mr whippy with loads of sauce

Adv 3: 5 scoops of chocolate sauce and sprinkles

Adv 4: Bubblegum with blue sauce

Connie: Coming Darren!

Anne: What's Mrs Maestro doing now.

Keith: She's staring into her purse.

Pat: She looks confused.

Connie: Like I said, Mrs Maestro's memory is not what it once was. Sometimes

she forgets. Sometimes she gets confused. Sometimes everyday tasks can become very challenging for her. *(To Mrs Maestro)* Mrs Maestro that's all of the String family on the bus. It's time to pay for all that ice

cream now.

Music ends

Mrs M: Of course, it'll be my pleasure; it was absolutely positively delicious!

Just a mo, I'm just trying to work out my money.

SFX Mrs M gets out her purse and empties her money into her tables. SFX Mrs M shuffling around with coins, scratching her head. She is confused. Connie: Don't worry Mrs Maestro, let's do it together. We'll help you. Isn't that

right gang?

Adventurers/Customers reactions - too right, no problem.

Mrs M: Thank you everyone. What am I like eh? Fit for scrap man I am!

SFX honk of the bus

Mrs M: Alright Darren keep your wig on! Ooh he's enough to drive you doolally

that lad. A face like a hippo's armpit. He's right though, look at the time. We'll never get the orchestra to the super-duper concert on time

at this rate. And we still have two more pickups.

Connie: Oh no, and I'm really looking forward to the concert. I hope we do

make it.

SFX honk of the bus

Connie: Coming Darren. I can see what you mean Mrs Maestro, he is moody.

Now whose got any money to pay for all this ice cream?

The customers react: I'll pay, no problem I've got this, no chance this is my treat, where's my wallet.

Ronnie: I don't think people pay with actual money any more Connie, do they?!

I'll tap my debit card.

Pat: That's nothing I've got Apple Pay on my phone. Stand back.

Keith: Out of the way, my smart watch is all I need to pay.

Ronnie: I'll pay

Pat: No let me pay.

Ronnie: No me.

Keith: Get out of it the watch is quicker.

Pat: Is not.

Keith: Is.

Pat: The phone is.

Keith: Smart watch.

Ronnie: Debit card! Oh forget it.

Connie: Will somebody just pay for our ice creams!

SFX of lots of different forms of payment card beeps and swipes, tills clinking, etc.

Connie: Thank you.

Mrs M: Well we picked up the woodwind family from the park and the strings

from the ice cream parlour, so next it must be the brass family from

the palace.

SFX Bus driving sounds

PROMOSWAP

Connie: While we make our way to the Palace adventurers. Let's pause our

journey of the imagination and have a listen to this. It's another

podcast that I think you'll like.

SFX Bus driving sounds. Pulling up.

Mrs M: We're here. The brass family in the Palace. Can you imagine it?

Music: The Palace

Mrs M: All the flags are waving, musicians take a bow, everybody's cheering,

the gates are open now.

SFX flags are waving, everybody cheering, a gate opening

Christine: Look Mrs Maestro is making hand gestures again inspired by the music.

Keith: First she pretends to move a flag backwards and forwards.

SFX flags waving in the wind

Anne: Then she uses her hands and arms to take a very fancy and royal-

looking bow.

SFX musicians taking a bow.

Pat: And then she throws both hands in the air and waves.

SFX everybody cheering

Linda: Finally she crosses her arms in front of her as if opening a pair of

enormous gates.

SFX a gate opening

Cyril: It's wonderful to watch.

Walter: I love how Mrs Maestro's hand gestures and movements are inspired

by the music.

Connie: Why don't you make gestures with your hands to represent the things

you can see in the great grand palace adventurers? Remember to be

guided by the music.

SFX Ding

Mrs M: All the flags are waving, musicians take a bow, everybody's cheering,

the gates are open now.

SFX flags are waving, everybody cheering, a gate opening

John O: That was amazing.

Walter: I've never been anywhere so grand as this.

Connie: What was it like being at a great grand palace adventurers?

SFX Ding

Adventurer's reactions:

Adv 1: It was so glamourous

Adv 2: Everything was big and fancy

Adv 3: Ive never been anywhere that grand before

Very regal.

Christine: What is Mrs Maestro up to now?

Cyril: She is sat in the corner all on her own.

Keith: She looks sort of sad looking.

John O: I hope she's ok.

Cyril: Connie go over and talk to her.

Connie: Mrs Maestro's memory is not what it once was. Sometimes she forgets.

Sometimes she gets confused. Sometimes things get a bit too much for

her.

Music ends

Connie: Mrs Maestro that's all of the Brass family on the bus. Are you ok?

Mrs M: I just need a few moments love and I'll be right as rain, I was a bit out

of my comfort zone back there.

Connie: I think we were all out of our comfort zone Mrs Maestro, it's not every

day you get to visit at a Palace.

Mrs M: No, I suppose not. But I do just need a few moments love. I'll be with

you in a jiffy. You get yourself on the bus chuck.

Connie: If you're sure.

Mrs M: I'm sure.

SFX Bus. People getting on more quietly than before. A moments quiet. Horn.

Mrs M: Ooh the concert! Sorry adventures, what am I like? We've got to get to

the super-duper concert on time. The conductor 1,2,3,4 will be waiting

for us. Next stop....the percussion from the disco! Off we go!

Music: Route Song (abridged):

Everybody sings Music, music, 1, 2, 3, 4.

Music, music, I've got to pick up an orchestra.

Music, music, 1, 2, 3, 4. And this is my order...

SFX Bus driving sounds. Pulling up.

Mrs M: We're here. The final pickup- the percussion family in the Disco. A

disco...? Can you imagine it?

Music: The Disco

Anne: (shouting over the music) This time Mrs maestro throws her arms in

the air one after the another...

Cyril: And then rolls them down one hand over the other.

Christine: Just like a disco dance move.

Connie: Why don't you do a disco dance move with your hands and arms

adventurers to the disco music? Ready, go!

SFX Ding

Christine: Listen adventurers, Mrs Maestro is doing a call and response with the

percussion instruments from the orchestra.

Pat: The musicians play a beat on their instrument and Mrs Maestro plays it

back on her body.

John O: I want a go at that.

Lilly: Me too.

Customers do call and response

Connie: You have a go at call and response adventures.

Adventurers do call and response

Pat: The music's stopped but Mrs M's still dancing look.

Walter: She's still lost in the moment.

Connie: Don't forget Mrs Maestro's memory is not what it once was. Sometimes

she forgets. Sometimes she gets lost in the moment- the music simply

sets her free.

Music ends

Mrs Maestro the whole orchestra is on the bus now. But look at the time. I don't think we'll make the super-duper concert on time now. I've just checked on Google maps and the traffic is terrible.

Mrs M: Don't worry Connie, I know a back route. When you've been in the bus

company game as long as I have, you get to know these things. The back route is a little bit well... bumpy, with a few surprises along the

way but if we use it, I'm sure we'll get us there on time.

Connie: Well, I'm looking on Google maps on my phone and I can't see any

back route.

Mrs M: Where we are going Connie, there are no maps!

SFX Da da daaaa

Music: Armchair Adventures theme tune fades in

Connie: Oh right. No maps. Bumpy, with a few surprises. Sounds. Well. An

adventure I suppose. But for that adventure adventurers, we will have
